It is the purchaser's responsibility to research other available information on the properties held in trust by the district. Other information sources may include the district clerk's records and the county clerk's records. Those records are not maintained or made available by the Appraisal District. We strongly suggest you view the GENERAL INFORMATION page found at www.mvbalaw.com. Bidders must satisfy themselves concerning the location and the condition of the property on the ground. Property is sold "AS IS" with all faults.

To bid on properties held in trust, send in a written bid with the following information:

When a bid is received, it is presented to the Chief Appraiser for approval. If the Chief Appraiser approves the bid, the bid is then sent to the entities for approval. If the bid is approved by all entities, you will be notified by phone that your bid was accepted.

When a bid is approved by all necessary entities, acceptable forms of payment are **cash**, **cashier's check or money order**. NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED. The appraisal district does not offer financing. Purchasers will receive a Tax Resale Deed which is without warranty, express or implied. Title to property is NOT guaranteed. A policy of title insurance may be difficult to obtain.
